### 3 Race Summary

#### 3.1 RACE HIGHLIGHTS

The 40th annual Palace Saloon 5K road race was run on April 12, 2014. There were 1,303 finishers down 86 from 2013 when 1,389 completed the 3.1 mile course. Chris Lake won with a time of 15:51. Amy Hines was the first female in at 17:45.

#### 3.2 BY THE NUMBERS SUMMARY

349 GWTC members finished the race this year 20 more than the 329 who raced in 2013. Note: The race was a grand prix race this year and not one in 2013. 84 GWTC members ordered the commemorative shirt, 230 chose a shirt, and 83 chose no shirt

1,209 registrations were entered through the Eventbrite system with 940 shirts orders. For comparison 863 of 1,029 Eventbrite orders included shirts in 2013 (See table 4.1). Ninety point three percent of the registered runners actually completed the race. 85% of the registrants called Tallahassee home. Eight days out from the race online registrations were 53% higher than the previous year. There were 118 race day registrations (walk-ups) this year while at least 144 were recorded in 2013.

Word of Mouth was the most cited means of how registrants reported hearing about the race.

#### 3.3 QUALITY SURVEY HIGHLIGHTS

A quality survey was sent out via email to registrants and posted on the Gulf Winds Track Club FaceBook page shortly after the race to solicit event feedback. Two hundred and sixty three responses were received. Quality survey ratings comparing this year to last are charted within Section 5 of this report. Four out of 5 categories showed incremental improvement with no category rated below 4 on a scale of 1 to 5. Expository comments related to the good, the bad (least liked), and the other are shown later in Section 5 with Pareto charts plotting the highest numbers of racer desires. A similar Pareto chart created for last year's race is also included for reference purposes. The top three issues in 2013, which accounted for 80% of the complaints all showed significant improvement in 2014. Complaints related to Beer lines dropped from 43(2013) to 7(2014); Timing (net) dropped from 21 (2013) to 1 (2014); and Water (taste) dropped from 17 (2013) to 0 (2014). Items to be addressed for 2015 include food and water access; finish area congestion; toilet facilities at the start; and public address system at the start. The distance between the start and finish was the second highest complaint with requests for a shuttle bus to bridge the distance.

#### 3.4 LOOKING AHEAD

A Palace Saloon 5K 2014 debrief meeting was held on April 24, 2014. In attendance were: Johnathan Manry, Elizabeth Rosario, Cole Tessier, Sondra Winter Lee, Bill lott, Tim Unger, Mike Rupp, Tom Perkins, Peg Griffin, Jeanne O'Kon, and Mike Burns. The survey results were thoroughly discussed and a variety of ideas were proposed to further improve the race event experience. Further work and meetings with stakeholders will be undertaken to address as many items as possible working on with the most heavily weighted ones first. [The complaints related to the Hill (#4 on the list) may have to wait for the next RD to address.]










